# **The Green Goals Community Fund**

The Green Goals Community Fund is an opportunity for local community or special interest groups to gain funding of up to £1,000 to kick-start green or healthy living projects.

To gain funding, a project needs to aim to:

- ✓ Improve the local environment
- ✓ Engage children and young people in environmental activities
- ✓ Raise community awareness of environmental issues
- ✓ Engage children and young people in healthy lifestyle activities
- ✓ Improve opportunities for active travel

#### So far it has supported 82 local community projects with £68,000 funding
